What is democracy? What does it represent, and is it truly for us? In Mali, we've been discussing democracy for decades, and not all the talk is good! Sometimes perceived as an "import" from the West in the 1990s, democracy was once associated with movements calling for greater freedoms and improved living conditions, raising many hopes. But today, it faces criticism - even rejection - by those who see it as a system ill-suited to our societies.

Is this really the case? Does democracy as we have known it since March 1991 align with our aspirations? What does democracy mean for Mali today?

Can we build a democracy rooted in our values and reflective of our current reality?

This book, produced by the Netherlands Institute for Multiparty Democracy (NIMD) in Mali, is based on the findings of a study into preconceptions and misperceptions about democracy. It aims to address these questions and serve as a teaching tool to enhance our understanding of democracy, so that every citizen can take ownership of its values and principles and become one of its architects.

Democracy needs informed and trained democrats, capable of building a fair and effective governance system. This graphic novel is dedicated to that vision.

Targeting young and older readers alike, we hope it will contribute to the consolidation of Mali's democracy, one that is secular, modern, dynamic and deeply rooted in positive cultural and universal values.
